

Dual Credit Courses

What is a Dual Credit Course?

A dual credit course is one recognized and granted credit by both a high school and a postsecondary institution. Although it is offered at the high school level, a dual credit is usually a college or university class. Dual credit courses are delivered by a post-secondary instructor and typically carry a heavier workload than a regular high school course.

Sask DLC only advertises dual credits as course options, dual credits are offered and taught through the post-secondary institution. All dual credit courses are offered and delivered from the post-secondary institution and students must pay all associated course costs and fees directly to the post-secondary institution.

Course layout and structure will vary as each was developed by a different educator and/or stem from different post-secondary institutions. These courses require a high degree of independent study. Students maybe required to purchase textbooks.

If you have a Registered Educational Savings Plan (RESP) you may be eligible to use those funds to pay for the course and textbooks as this is a post-secondary course – check with your financial institution to see if it qualifies.

Dual credit courses can fill up and close at anytime. Course closure is at the direction of the postsecondary institution.
