



Disclosure of Wrongdoing Form

([Reporting Wrongdoing Administrative Procedure](#))

The form should be used to disclose a wrongdoing. The form is prescribed under *The Public Interest Disclosure Regulations*.

Under section 10(1) of *The Public Interest Disclosure Act* (PIDA), where a Sask DLC employee reasonably believes that he or she has information that could show that a wrongdoing has been committed or is about to be committed, or that could show that an employee has been asked to commit a wrongdoing, the employee may make a disclosure to:

- the Designated Officer for Sask DLC; or
- the Public Interest Disclosure Commissioner.
