Purpose

- This administrative procedure outlines the framework for the delivery and management of the Canadian citizenship education program at Saskatchewan Distance Learning Centre (Sask DLC).

Scope

- This administrative procedure applies to students and staff at Sask DLC.

Policy Statement

- Sask DLC is committed to providing high-quality Canadian citizenship education that enables learners to acquire the knowledge, skills and values essential for understanding Canadian society, history and governance.
- All students in Sask DLC are to receive instruction in Canadian citizenship and participate in patriotic observances and exercises in order to provide focus to the importance of these activities in society.

Procedures:

1. Sask DLC will display a highly visible photo of the current monarch.
 2. Sask DLC will display the Canadian and Saskatchewan flags (refer to <https://www.canada.ca/en/canadian-heritage/services/flag-canada-etiquette/flying-rules.html>).
 3. Sask DLC will display the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms.
 4. Sask DLC will play “O Canada” at Sask DLC graduation ceremonies.
 5. Sask DLC will observe Remembrance Day.
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
